- All entries must be postmarked by April 9, 2012 including Digital Photos, CD/DVD, Entry Form, Entry Fee (\$25/2 pieces) and Jury Notification Form. Please include your email address.
- Notification of accepted or rejected works will be made via email by April 16.
- Delivery of accepted work: April 27, 2012 between 10:30am and 2:30pm at the Johnston County Agricultural Center Auditorium located at 2736 NC Highway 210, Smithfield, NC

Eligible Works

All original works are eligible for entry. Artwork must have been completed in the past three years. The exhibit is open to all artists (18 years or older) residing in North Carolina.

Accepted Mediums:

Oils, Acrylic, Watercolor, Mixed Media, Colored Pencils, Pastels, Pencil, Charcoal, Pen & Ink and Photography

Awards

\$350 in cash prizes will be awarded by the juror.

- 1st Place-\$100 Each, Painting and Photograph
- 2nd Place-\$ 50 Each Painting and Photography
- 3rd Place-\$ 25 Each Painting and Photograph

Exhibition Date

The exhibit will be held during the Third Annual Johnston County Arts Council Art and Food Festival, scheduled for April 27, 2012 at 6:30 pm.

JCAC reserves the right to photograph events and use any or all images for publicity.

Sales

All sales will be payable to the artist. JCAC will retain a commission of 10% which the artist will remit to JCAC. Artwork not for sale should be marked "NFS". We will not accept work marked "Price on Request."

Display of Work

All artwork must be framed and securely placed on artist provided easels. All works must be matted and framed under glass or Plexiglass except oils and acrylics treated like oils. Work on canvas with finished edges is acceptable. No frames that leave the edges of the glass exposed will be accepted. Entries should not exceed 45" in any direction (including the frame). The show has limited space to display art.

JCAC reserves the right to reject any entry that is not suitable for display.

Delivery & Return of Work

All accepted work must be hand-delivered to the Johnston County Agricultural Center Auditorium-located at 2736 NC Highway 210, Smithfield, NC on April 27 between 10.30am and 2.30pm.

All artwork must remain until 9:30 pm on April 27.

Liability

JCAC is not responsible for theft or damage. Artist is responsible for any insurance deductible. JCAC will not be responsible for minor nicks to frames, breakage of glass, scratches to plexiglass or damage to art work.

Rules for Entry

• Artists must submit the following items to the Johnston County Arts Council, 312 South 3rd Street, Smithfield, NC, 27577, 919-938-0306.

- **Digital Images:** Provide unenhanced, and unmanipulated jpeg (jpg) images oriented properly on a CD/DVD. or by email attachment to
- knobles4@nc.rr.com. Send JPGS with .jpg extensions, no more than 1000 pixels, in the long dimension at a browser resolution of 72dpi.

- **Do NOT send files that are embedded in any applications that must be run to view the jpg. Send no files that end in exe!**

• **CDs/DVDs will not be returned.** Images must depict the artwork accurately. Package CDs with adequate padding. CDs are brittle and can break.

• Use as file names the artist's initials followed by the image number as given on the Entry Form and one word from the image title. **For example**, the file name of Jane Doe's image, Little Bear, #1 on her Entry Form would be jd1bear.jpg. Only two entries may be submitted on a CD or DVD with one image of each entry.

- Entry fee: \$25 for two pieces. Only 2 pieces per artist.

Checks should be made to the Johnston County Arts Council. All entries are non-refundable. Payments may be made using PayPal at the Johnston County Arts Council website www.jcartscouncil.org.

Check List:

Entry form: Complete the entry form, making sure the labeling of jpg images corresponds with the form.

Jury Notification Form: Complete the notification form, making sure digital images correspond with the form. Without the jury and entry forms, jpeg files sent by email do not constitute acceptance for the jury process. Please mail jury and entry forms to the JCAC address to complete the application process.

All entries must be postmarked no later than April 9, 2012.
